

Trauma Informed Care (TIC) Implementation Assessment Options 2024 Fee Schedule

Option	Cost	Description
<p>OPTION 1: FULL EXTERNAL ASSESSMENT Virtual or in-person</p>	<p>\$9,500</p>	<p>This external full implementation assessment can be a combination of in-person or virtual meetings and data collection. It includes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A launch meeting with leadership and the I-Lab 2. An in-person or virtual site visit to observe your physical environment 3. Interviews with 2-4 key staff members 4. A customized staff web survey and written survey report 5. Collection of consumer input 6. Document review 7. Generation of preliminary assessment scores and recommendations 8. A facilitated review to finalize the preliminary scores with site leadership 9. A final written comprehensive report that can be used for planning purposes 10. A warm hand-off to Trauma Informed Oregon. 11. <i>Sites will have the option to access one paid virtual or in-person full external follow-up assessment for the reduced cost of \$4,500 if they request it within 18 months of the previous full external assessment. Follow-up reports include charts of changes in implementation ratings over time.</i> <p><i>Additional fees for cost of travel to in-person assessment sites will be negotiated based on location.</i></p>
<p>OPTION 2: CUSTOMIZED ALL-STAFF TIC WEB SURVEY</p>	<p>\$4,000</p>	<p>This customized all-staff web survey will provide data needed for an internal self-assessment of TIC implementation. Survey questions are directly tied to indicators in the Trauma Informed Care Implementation Assessment Tool developed by Trauma Informed Oregon and the PSU I-Lab. The web-survey includes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Survey questions directly tied to indicators in the TIC Implementation Assessment Tool 2. Customized response options to match the departments, staffing and terminology used by your site. 3. The option to add additional questions (to reduce the burden of multiple staff surveys) 4. A written survey report 5. A virtual review of the written survey report

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OPTION 3: FACILITATED MULTI-RATER SELF ASSESSMENT	\$2,500	<p>This facilitated self-assessment will result in a written report of scores determined internally by the site. It includes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A one-hour orientation with site leadership and the I-Lab 2. An online TIC Implementation Self-Assessment survey for up to 6 respondents or department heads to score themselves 3. A preliminary report of average scores across respondents 4. A facilitated review of the average scores with site leadership to come to consensus around a single self-assessment score for each TIC standard. 5. A final written report of implementation scores for each element of TIC and each standard within those elements. 6. A warm hand-off to Trauma Informed Oregon, if desired.
OPTION 4: ONLINE SELF-ASSESSMENT	\$1,500	<p>Organizations are welcome to download a PDF of the TIC Implementation Assessment Instrument or fill one out online for their own reference. The survey will generate an automated report for planning purposes. (Please contact info@hsimplementationlab.org for a customized survey link). Family-serving organizations in Oregon may contact us for low or no-cost self-assessment options.</p>
Additional HOURLY CONSULTATION	\$200	<p>One hour of consultation with the I-Lab or Trauma Informed Oregon</p>
Travel to Site	Varies by location	<p>Fees for cost of travel for in-person assessment or consultation will be negotiated based on location.</p>
Individual a la carte services from Option 1	Varies by service	<p>Examples: Collection of consumer input, document review, key informant interviews with verbal report</p>
