

# Trauma Informed Care (TIC)

## Implementation Assessment Options

### 2025 Fee Schedule

Option	Cost	Description
<p><b>OPTION 1: FULL EXTERNAL ASSESSMENT</b> Virtual or in-person</p>	<p><b>\$11,000</b></p>	<p>This external full implementation assessment can be a combination of in-person or virtual meetings and data collection. It includes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A launch meeting with leadership and the iLab</li> <li>2. An in-person or virtual site visit to observe your physical environment</li> <li>3. Interviews with 2-4 key staff members</li> <li>4. A customized staff web survey and written survey report</li> <li>5. Consumer input (web survey, focus groups, or existing data)</li> <li>6. Document review</li> <li>7. Generation of preliminary assessment scores and recommendations</li> <li>8. A facilitated review to finalize the preliminary scores with site leadership</li> <li>9. A final written comprehensive report that can be used for planning purposes</li> <li>10. A warm hand-off to Trauma Informed Oregon.</li> <li>11. <i>Sites will have the option to access one paid virtual or in-person full external follow-up assessment for the reduced cost of \$4,500 if they request it within 18 months of the previous full external assessment. Follow-up reports include charts of changes in implementation ratings over time.</i></li> </ol> <p><b><i>Additional fees for cost of travel to in-person assessment sites will be negotiated based on location.</i></b></p>
<p><b>OPTION 2: CUSTOMIZED ALL-STAFF TIC WEB SURVEY</b></p>	<p><b>\$5,000</b></p>	<p>This customized all-staff web survey will provide data needed for an internal self-assessment of TIC implementation. Survey questions are directly tied to indicators in the Trauma Informed Care Implementation Assessment Tool developed by Trauma Informed Oregon and the PSU iLab. The web-survey includes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Survey questions directly tied to the TIC principles in the Implementation Assessment Tool</li> <li>2. Customized response options to match the departments, staffing and terminology used by your site.</li> <li>3. The option to add additional questions (to reduce the burden of multiple staff surveys)</li> <li>4. A written survey report</li> <li>5. A virtual review of the written survey report</li> </ol>

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<b>OPTION 3: FACILITATED MULTI-RATER SELF ASSESSMENT</b>	<b>\$3,000</b>	<p>This facilitated self-assessment will result in a written report of scores determined internally by the site. It includes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A one-hour orientation with site leadership and the iLab</li> <li>2. An online TIC Implementation Self-Assessment survey for up to 6 respondents or department heads to score themselves</li> <li>3. A preliminary report of average scores across respondents</li> <li>4. A facilitated review of the average scores with site leadership to come to consensus around a single self-assessment score for each TIC standard.</li> <li>5. A final written report of implementation scores for each element of TIC and each standard within those elements.</li> <li>6. A warm hand-off to Trauma Informed Oregon, if desired.</li> </ol>
<b>OPTION 4: ONLINE SELF-ASSESSMENT</b>	<b>\$1,750</b>	<p>Organizations may fill out the TIC Implementation Assessment Instrument online for their own reference. The online form will generate an automated report for planning purposes. Contact <a href="mailto:info@hsimplementationlab.org">info@hsimplementationlab.org</a> for a customized survey link. (Family-serving organizations in Oregon may be eligible for completing the online form at no cost.)</p>
<b>Additional HOURLY CONSULTATION</b>	<b>\$250</b>	<p>One hour of consultation with the iLab or Trauma Informed Oregon</p>
<b>Travel to Site</b>	<b>Varies by location</b>	<p>Fees for cost of travel for in-person assessment or consultation will be negotiated based on location.</p>
<b>Individual a la carte services from Option 1</b>	<b>Varies by service</b>	<p>Examples: Collection of consumer input, document review, key informant interviews with verbal report</p>
